Grades 6-8

STEP 1 Log in to your Teacher Portal <u>HERE</u>.

STEP 3 Enter the required information, and then click "Save."

When your students log in, they should be able to see the lesson(s) you just created. If they were already logged in, they will need to log out and log back in to see them.

YOUR CUSTOM TYPING CONTENT:

With its cold weather and short days, the season of winter often gets a bad rap. The good news is that after the winter solstice on December 21st, every day will get a little bit longer and have increasingly more sunlight. What is the winter solstice? So glad you asked! The winter solstice is the day when the earth is tilted furthest from the sun. It also is considered the shortest day of the year because there is the least amount of sunlight. Technically, the winter solstice marks the first day of winter (which will last until the vernal equinox in March), though depending on where you live, it may feel like winter much earlier in the year.
