YOUR CUSTOM TYPING CONTENT:

On the second Monday in October, many people across the United States celebrate Indigenous Peoples' Day. This relatively new holiday was originally created as a counter-celebration of Columbus Day (which some felt glorified the violence of colonization). Indigenous people are the native or first people to live in a specific place. There are between 370 and 500 million indigenous people worldwide, and between 2.5 and 6 million in the United States.
