If you've ever visited or seen pictures of New York City, you know that the skyline is dominated by towering skyscrapers. The tallest of all of these buildings (and in fact the tallest in the entire United States) is One World Trade Center (formerly known as the Freedom Tower). This massive building was constructed after the original World Trade Center was destroyed in the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. Including the tower's spire, the building measures 1,776 feet tall. This specific height was intentionally designed to represent the year 1776 when the Declaration of Independence was signed.
