## YOUR CUSTOM TYPING CONTENT:

On May 24th, 1844, long-distance communication history was made. On this day, the first message sent by Morse Code traveled from Washington, D.C., to Baltimore. While this may not seem like a very long distance to the modern-day person, the most effective form of long-distance communication prior to this was mailing a letter (which in those days could take up to a week). Morse Code uses a series of dots, dashes, and spaces to represent letters, numbers, and punctuation. A telegraph then turns the symbols into electrical signals and sends them via wire to their destination. Morse code played an important role in WWII and is still used today to send emergency signals.
